

Livonia Auctioneer Receives Top Honors That Less Than 1% Worldwide Have Achieved

Bloomington, Indiana, April 17, 2008—Professional Auctioneer Kenny Lindsay of American Eagle Auction & Appraisal Company based out of Livonia, Michigan has successfully completed an extensive three year executive program and has earned the National Auctioneers Association (NAA) Education Institute's honored Certified Auctioneers Institute (CAI) designation.

The CAI designation is equivalent to a PhD in the auction profession and is the most respected education program in the country for Auctioneers. Less than 1% of auctioneers worldwide have achieved the CAI status.
